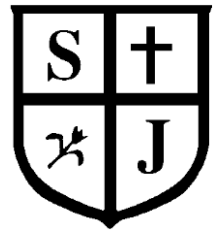

- To support teachers and other adults in our schools to encourage pupils to make connections in their numeracy and mathematics lessons to **real life contexts** and with other areas of their school experiences.

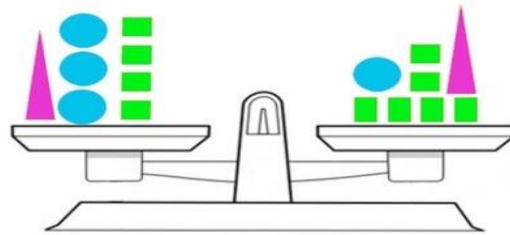
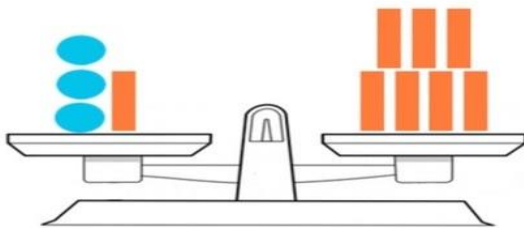
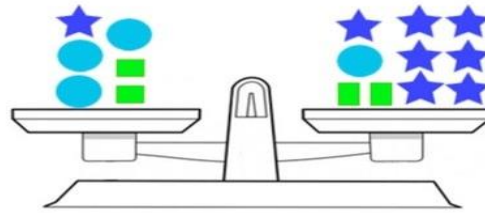
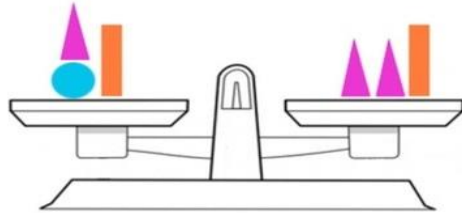
