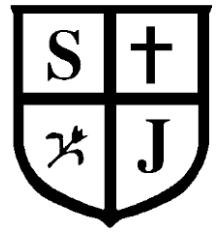

**Times Tables:**

We are having a big focus across school on recall of times table facts. Please help your child to practise at home.

Below is a reminder of the year group **expectations:**

Year 1 – Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s

Year 2 – X2, X10, X5

Year 3 – X3, X4, X6, X8

Year 4 – All times tables up to 12x12

Year 5 – All times tables up to 12x12

Year 6 – All times tables up to 12x12

Remember to encourage your child to use '**Times Table Rockstars**' and '**Mathletics**' at home. Every children from Year 2 to Year 6 should have been given a log in by their class teacher!
