National History Museum

On Monday the Year 6 children will be engaging in a virtual session live with the National History Museum in London! During the workshop the class will be trained as scientists, and they will go on a scientific mission to find out more about evolution. They will travel through Earth's history searching for evidence of change over time. they will complete different challenges in this engaging workshop to look at real world examples and current research, make predictions and test their knowledge, using observations to draw conclusions, finding out how scientists use evidence.
