Dear Parents/Carers

What a term this has been, we would like to take the opportunity to sincerely thank you for continuing to work with us in such stressful and difficult times. Thank you for the messages of support we have received; these are greatly appreciated and make such a difference to our team. Also, please know that we are here for you and if you need to speak to any member of staff; please do get in touch via the school office. If there is ever a problem, we will do our utmost to support and help you! Please find enclosed in this letter all of the information you should need for your child to return to school **on Monday 25th April.**

School Uniform

When we return all children should be in full school uniform. As it is the Summer term children may return in Summer Uniform.

- **Boys** may wear polo shirts and shorts; they can also continue to wear the winter uniform of shirt and tie and grey trousers.
- **Girls** may wear **purple or yellow** gingham dresses.
- **All children** should wear black school shoes, **not trainers**.
- May we also remind parents that only small stud earrings and watches are permitted. Nail varnish is not allowed.
- In the summer term we will still allow the children to come to school wearing their PE kit on PE days **however** for the PE we ask that the children wear a yellow or white PE top, this can be a school branded top or a plain top, it can also be a plain t-shirt or a polo shirt. (Any child who comes into school not wearing a correct PE top will be provided with a top to wear.) School Jumper/Cardigan must be worn and Black/Navy or any dark coloured leggings or jogging bottoms or shorts. They will also need to wear trainers; they will wear this outfit all day. Your child will need black pumps for indoor PE, these can be sent in on their return to school – please ensure you write their name in them.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club will be available from Monday 25th April from 8am. Thanks to Father Sean and the Parish we continue to provide this as a free service to all pupils from Reception – Year 6. Please contact school by telephone to reserve a place, it will be given on a first come first served basis.

Return to school arrangements – Summer term

- Morning arrangements will stay as they are for the summer term
 - **Infant doors 8:40 – 8:55am**
 - **Junior doors 8:50 – 9:00am**
- End of day times will be different for the INFANTS after Easter
 - **Infant doors 3:00pm**
 - **Junior doors 3:10pm**
 - All exits will remain the same and children will be only leave at their specified times unless proof of appointment is provided to the school office.
