Monday	When playing with the children (linked to their interests wherever possible) include the vocabulary of subtraction. For example, you have six dinosaurs. If I take away/ subtract 4 how many do you have now? (Start with numbers to six and adjust to your child's level of understanding.)	Today listen to ' Stomp Dinosaur Stomp ' by Margaret Mayo and Alex Ayliffe https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rLnYIKsyYJU Listen to this new dinosaur story. Talk about what is the same or different about this book and the one we listened to last week. Can they hear any of the same words? Do they have the same dinosaurs in? Do they both rhyme? Paint or draw the 10 dinosaurs when you have finished.
Tuesday	Using a box or a paper bowl cut a hole in the side to create a dinosaur cave (link to child's interests). Use figures that can fit inside. Ask children questions such as I have 5 dinosaurs but two go inside the cave. How many do I have now? This can be extended further. For example, we have 5 dinosaurs. Close your eyes (hide three in the cave). How many can you see now? So how many are in the cave? That's correct I took away three. Lift up the box and check.(Start with numbers to six, adjust to your child's level of understanding.)	We have been reading rhyming books about dinosaurs. Now it is time to learn all about them.
