

Children's University 'More Able' Virtual Sessions

Enrich Education and the Children's University will be offering a number of free 'More Able' (formerly 'Gifted and Talented') virtual workshops in English & Maths in the coming weeks. These virtual sessions will be of a dynamic and challenging nature, aimed at enhancing the skills that some young people have already displayed signs of possessing.

The school have identified pupils they feel will benefit from participating in the session. Furthermore, children who are involved in the Children's University will gain 2 credits for attending the virtual session.

The first virtual session will have an English/creative writing and poetry focus. This will be an opportunity for children to become more familiar with several poetic devices and then use these to construct their own poems. Children will become more familiar with the use of similes, metaphors, personification and kennings in poetry. They will explore examples of these poetic devices in the work of different writers and experiment with writing some themselves. After looking at some 'short poems' (Haikus, Cinquains etc) for inspiration, they will then draft one or more of their own short (3 line?) poems, based on a nature theme and constructed using a metaphor, personification and a kenning.
