Due to the Queens Platinum Jubilee there will be an additional days holiday in 2022, therefore please note the change of end of Summer term to Tuesday 19th July.


Breakfast Club

There is a Breakfast Club from 8.00am each morning. This club is available for pupils from Reception – Year 6 and must be booked in advance. From September the club will return to the cost of £1.50 per day and the club is not for pupils in Nursery.

School uniform

When purchasing your childs uniform for September please consider the following:

- Just a polite reminder that neither trainers nor Converse are classed as school shoes. Letters will be sent home with individual children who persistently come to school without the required school uniform/footwear
- Our PE kit is a gold or yellow t-shirt, navy blue shorts and pumps, the children may continue to come into school in their PE kit on PE days.
 From September we will introduce the option of a plain white t-shirt as an alternative top, we will continue to allow the children to wear plain dark coloured leggings or joggers for PE.
- Only small stud earrings are permitted in school
- Please make sure you write your childs name in their clothes, particularly jumpers and coats.
- Mobile phones are not allowed in school other than in exceptional circumstances and then they must be locked during the school day. Please note the school accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen mobile phones.



Summer Reading Challenge- Wild World Heroes
