Curriculum Enrichment

Statistics Day

Today we have a special maths focus day where our Junior classes have been exploring Statistics and how they can be useful in 'real life'

Year 3 have been constructing pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables. They have been asking and answering questions about the data they have compared.

Year 4 have been presenting data using bar charts, pictograms and tables and using information to solve one step and two step problems.

Year 5 have been learning to present and interpret data using bar charts and time graphs, they have been solving problems using information presented in different ways. **Year 6** have been completing, reading, and interpreting information in tables, they have been solving problems using information in line graphs.
