#### Key Stage 2 Swimming

Unfortunately, the Volair pool is closed for refurbishments during the time that our swimming sessions were booked in. Therefore, they have cancelled our sessions and no other local pool can offer alternative options. This is very disappointing for us, especially as our sessions were booked months in advance and are an important part of our school year. We are currently looking to provide another alternative later in the school year or looking at doubling our swimming offer in the next academic year. Year 6 swimming is not currently affected by this disruption.



## **Headlice**

We have recently been informed about an outbreak of head lice in two classes. Please check your child's hair. If you are at all worried, please contact the school for our School Nurse details or, alternatively, your pharmacist or family doctor. Head lice are very good at moving from one host to another therefore it is important that long hair is tied up, this will reduce the spread of lice. Please encourage your child not to take their own / or their friends hair out of the bobble/plait that you put it in, this will stop the spread of lice.
