### **Applications for Primary places in Knowsley**

The application process for September 2024 entry to Reception class of primary school and Year 7 transfer to secondary school will begin this month.

Full information regarding the process will be made available on the council admissions page Apply for a school place | Knowsley Council no later than 12<sup>th</sup> September 2023 and will include access to the online application portal which Knowsley residents can use to make an application for September 2024 entry.

The closing date to guarantee your application for Year 7 secondary transfer is considered in the initial allocation is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023, Pupils applying to All Saints must also complete a supplementary form available from the school office.

The closing date to guarantee your application for Reception class entry is considered in the initial allocation is 15 January 2024. Pupils applying to a Catholic School must also complete a supplementary form available from the school office. Please note to be considered as a Catholic applicant you must produce evidence that your child was Baptised before 15th January 2024.
