The closing date to guarantee your application for Year 7 secondary transfer is considered in the initial allocation is 31st October 2023, Pupils applying to All Saints must also complete a supplementary form available from the school office. The closing date to guarantee your application for Reception class entry is considered in the initial allocation is 15 January 2024. Pupils applying to a Catholic School must also complete a supplementary form available from the school office. Please note to be considered as a Catholic applicant you must produce evidence that your child was Baptised before 15th January 2024.
