When I was first ordained priest in 1996 the usual Mass offering was £5 per Mass Intention. To allow for inflation since then, the equivalent value would be £11.76 per Mass! There is extra car parking space at the back of the Presbytery, off Bewley Drive and then, walk through the back garden & 'Collins Room' to the back of Church.

The regular visiting of the elderly and vulnerable, with the need for new Eucharistic Ministers to have DBS checks, means we currently cannot normally provide communion visits at home. If parishioners are house-bound and their condition is likely to continue to keep them at home for the longer term, please telephone the presbytery and Fr Sean will arrange a visit for the Sacrament of the Sick and Holy Communion.

Fr Sean is the Catholic Chaplain to Alder Hey Children's Hospital.

He also provides some holiday-cover & some weekly night-cover to the Royal & Broadgreen Hospitals & Aintree Hospital Chaplaincy priests. If a parishioner is ill in hospital, please ask family to inform nursing staff that they are Catholic and wish to be seen by a Catholic Chaplain.

The diocese will give us an interest-free loan to clear our current £100k overdraft, but over five years **we will then need to raise the extra £20,000 each year** to pay off the loan itself **and we then also need extra weekly income** to meet our annual running costs that still put us in the red. In brief we need to more than double our weekly offertory collection to repay the loan, and we then need more in addition each week to meet the week-to-week increased running costs each year. A WARM WELCOME to everyone at Church this week. We also **Welcome** any visitors who may be joining us or their families this weekend.

As we move through this month the dead continue to be a focus in the life of the Church. We pray for them all the time, but in November they have a particular focus in our prayers.

Our November Dead lists are another way to remember all our loved ones, - those long dead and the more recently died. There are sheets at the back of Church for you to write their names on and put into the envelopes for the Masses to be said for all the names on the Dead Lists during this month. You can also put donations in the envelope for the November Masses. The final thing we can do for those who have lived and have now died is to pray for them and the funeral prayers and at Masses since they have died, help them on their final journey back to God. These prayers and Masses also help us who remain on earth and give comfort and peace. We pray for them and the dead help us with their continuing prayers for us: the 'communion of saints'.

All Children and their Families are WELCOME to Mass EVERY week, as part of their family-catechesis, 'Living-out' of the faith.

Children's Confession will also be celebrated each weekend, come early before weekend Masses in Church

and ask to celebrate on the chairs in front of the Tabernacle .
