# **'EDUCATION SUNDAY'**

A warm **WELCOME** to everyone at Mass at Church this weekend.

Bishop Tom Williams completed his Visitation of our Parish and its schools this week and got to see a lot of the classes in both St Joseph the Worker and St Laurence's Catholic Primary schools. He had previously visited All Saints Catholic High School before the Summer holidays. We do have a wonderful parish community, and it is from our parish community that our Catholic schools were built to continue the work of passing on the faith of our ancestors to each new generation. This relies on each of us deepening our understanding of the faith and sharing it with others. This builds on but can't replace the faith-filled family at Home, which is fed at Church and School and is positively developed by families supporting their children to attend Church and School.

The 'Kirkby Family of Parishes', in Westvale, Northwood, Tower Hill and Southdene is formed from this four-district Catholic community, and some services and events may happen in future in a different parish church rather than our own. The reality now is that we only have 2½ Catholic Priests for Kirkby. Some days of the week Mass may only be available in another Kirkby Catholic Church, and we are encouraged to find out where these other churches are and help to build up a Kirkby-wide Catholic family community, by attending these other Catholic Churches from time to time.

I would again like to encourage people to come to weekend Mass and look to attend some weekday Masses/services too. Jesus gives Himself and His graces that help us, in a special way at Mass. **Without Mass we will wither.** However, the faith will survive and thrive if people consider it to be a precious gift to pass on to new generations, if faith-filled people share the faith with other people and continue to build up the faith community across Kirkby.
