If people <u>are dying don't wait until their final hours to call for the Priest.</u>*

Fr Sean is the Catholic Chaplain to Alder Hey Children's Hospital . He also provides some holiday-cover & some weekly night-cover to the Aintree Hospital Chaplaincy priests. If a parishioner is ill in hospital, please ask family to inform nursing staff that they want to be registered as Catholic and wish to be seen by the Catholic Chaplain on call.
