For the regular visiting of the elderly and vulnerable, we need new Eucharistic Ministers to have DBS checks, so we currently cannot normally provide regular communion visits at home, but if parishioners are house-bound and their condition is likely to continue to keep them at home for the longer term, please telephone the presbytery and Fr Sean will arrange a visit for the Sacrament of the Sick and Holy Communion. *Please remind everyone that this is not just for those who are dying, but for the sick. If people are dying don't wait until their final hours to call for the Priest.*

Fr Sean is the Catholic Chaplain to **Alder Hey Children's Hospital**. He also provides some holiday-cover & some weekly night-cover to the Aintree Hospital Chaplaincy priests. If a parishioner is ill in hospital, please ask family to inform nursing staff that they want to be registered as Catholic and wish to be seen by the Catholic Chaplain on call.

A warm **WELCOME** to everyone at Mass at Church this weekend. A particular **Welcome** to our families who are preparing for the living-out of the next Sacraments. A special **Welcome** to other families who have been especially invited to Masses this weekend- we have invited all those who have had their children baptised here in the last twelve months for today's Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Today with the Baptism of the adult Jesus by John, in the River Jordan, we have further news of great joy.

The Nativity Feast continues, an 8-day, 12-day and then continuing season to the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. Now, at least keep the crib up ....there is an older tradition of the season continuing for 40-days to the Feast of the Presentation of the Child Jesus in the Temple 2<sup>nd</sup> February. After all the preparation of Advent, the feast is giving time for us to absorb the significance of the baby born for us: He is Christ, the Lord! God made flesh & Blood, Human and Divine. The baby, 'Jesus', is the one who saves, grows up into the adult Jesus, 'God saves' us. What does God save us from? This question takes some time to investigate and, in the meantime, tweaking it slightly, God saves us to LIVE lives of faith, hope and love, here in the present time and in the time to come, life with God for ever in the heavenly kingdom. That starts NOW! New Year resolution time:- let us accept God's invitation to join Him in the adventure of life. This needs many things and we need companions on the journey of life. We need to break bread together in the presence of God and be fed by God to help us to live. Ask someone to come back to Mass with you and together we will rediscover the abiding presence of Jesus, Emmanuel, God is with us!
